



The WiltonLogic Client test system has been designed in a series of modules to allow potential customers to sample the range of tests available and the style in which they have been constructed. Each module consists of a small number of tests centered round a particular theme. At the end of the module the user can obtain a sample of critical data from each of the tests.

We consider that there are three critical elements to our test design:

- 1) We use guided tutorials to introduce each test to the study participant. We do not allow the study participants to skip these tutorials as we want each participant to receive the same training.
- 2) We rely on simple spoken instructions to introduce the test, and our questionnaire administration routines include the option for the test statements to be spoken. In this way testing can be carried out with study participant with limited literacy skills.
- 3) As far as possible we avoid using language-based testing material (with the obvious exception of the self-report questionnaires!). We believe this helps to minimize potential cross-cultural differences. We also appreciate the importance of translational research (comparison of human test subjects to non-human test subjects) to building our understanding of the biological basis of behavior, human mental health and brain function. We believe that relying on language or numerical based testing creates a barrier to translational research.

When considering applying these tests to a research problem or clinical testing need, clients should bear in mind that the tests included in each module are independent of one another, and can be mixed-and-matched in any combination to address client needs. WiltonLogic also has additional tests which have not yet been included in the Client Test System, but which are available for inclusion in a tailored test battery. In general more data are collected by the test software than that are shown on the screen/printout at the end of each CTS module, and trial-based tests also preserve a record of data on a trial-by-trial basis.

WiltonLogic is also happy to discuss lengthening, shortening or changing the difficulty levels in any of the tests according to clients needs, so long as this maintains the scientific validity of the test. WiltonLogic is also willing to consider changing the visual and auditory material in the test battery. Although today the test instructions are only available in English, we are also committed in the long-term to translating the instructions into other, without affecting the mechanics of the tests themselves. WiltonLogic is also willing to discuss the development of new tests or incorporation of clients own material into test batteries where intellectual property considerations allow. We have also been able to link WiltonLogic testing software to software provided by other suppliers to provide a seamless testing experience.
